Notes for Stanley Percy HASS:

Stanley Percival Hass applied for his social security number 345-10-1152 in 1936 at the age of 37.

He lived in Hinsdale, Illinois and worked for a manufacturing company, which had a branch in Chicago, Illinois.

Stanley P Hass was a practical joker. He used to take all kinds of ga-joke tricks, like a handshake buzzer, wiht him every time he went back to Canada to visit family. The best was the time he put a whoopie cushion under his mother's chair. She was a little old lady then. When she sat down it was hilarious. His face was red and he didn't stop laughing for two weeks.

It is thought that he moved with his wife to California in 1944.

A letter written to Grandson, David W. Hass, dated August 4th, 1960, reads as follows: Dear Rattlesnake Dave! Over the weekend I went to our hilly desert after a terrific battle I was successful in being the victor over "Pete". It was a gloomy day so the ten and twenty foot rattlers kept away from me. They were either afraid of me or didn't like the smell of y hair tonic, or maybe my feet. I removed the venom from Pete. Since he will be growing up in a domestic atmosphere he should be a good pal to Theodore. Poor Pete is in a serious condition temporarity. In chasing him in the desert I awakened a 300 pound wolf who stepped on his back and crushed it. Our vet saved his life by attaching or insterting a means of furnishing oxygen to his little lungs. I know with your care and nursing this equipment may be discareded in the near future, Rattlesnake Dave. Pete's father, morhter, and little brother join me in wishing you much future happiness together. Pete's diet consists of burrs, Canadian thistles, rose throns, toe nails, and snails as a tenderizer. Nice striking, Grandpa "Python" Hass

"He had a parakeet named "Petey." On our trip in 1960, when we visited there, this bird could talk and everything. They would let him out and he would fly all over their house in Pasadena. In their fenced in backyard, they had a tortoise that would live in the corner that I liked to go and look at. They had a lot of hummingburds and fruit trees." David W. Hass, June 1996.

"I only saw him twice, when we went out to California (about 1960 and 1967). He had a pink Cadillac with a Burmuda carriage bell he would ding and kids would laugh at it." David W Hass, 20 Jul 2018

Before retiring, Stan was with Royal Typewriter as a sales manager. They lived at 3611 Copeland Place, Los Angeles, California. While he was retired, he worked as a night watchman at Max Factor.

Stanley P. Hass was diagnosed with prostate cancer in the summer of 1970. In 1971, four months after abeing diagnosed with cancer of the lungs and spine, spinal surgery was done, which left him bedridden with paralysis from the waist down for the tree months until his death at 73 years old on January 25, 1872. He suffered from terminal bronchopneumonia his last two days.

Grandson David W. Hass has Stanley's green felt beret from a club in Toronto, where Stanley was once a member,

Dorothy Edith DUBRICK was buried on 19 Sep 1993 in Live Oaks Cemetery, Monrovia, California.

Notes for Dorothy Edith DUBRICK:

Dorothy Edith DuBrick lived in Los Angeles County, California for 49 years until her death. It is thought that she moved from Hinsdale, Illinois to California about 1944, when she was 39 years old. She lived at 3611 Copeland Place, Los Angeles, California for soem tiem before living at 1402 East 3rd, Duarte, Los Angeles County, California.

Even though she was a grandmother, she let everyone, including all her grandkids call her Dorothy.

She worked in a card store in Pasadena on the street that the Rose Parade when passed. She suffered from atherosclerotic heart disease and senile dementia for many years before her death.

#### Notes for Donald Albert DROWN:

Donald Albwert Drown was a WWII POW. He survived the Bataan Death March. (Bataan is a peninsula on an island in the Philippines. It was to Bataan that American and Filipino forces retreated from Manila. General MacAArthur and brave defenders withstood devastating Japanese attack for many weeks in 1942. After General MacArthur's transfer to Australia in March of 1942, General Wainright took command of the defending forces. When supplies and reinforcements were prevented from reaching American's armed forces on the peninsula by Japanese intervention, the defenders were weakened by disease, malnutrition, and exhaustion. Ceaseless battle marked the last fifteen days fo Bataan's resistance. Although many broken troops took refuge on Corregidor, approximately 35,000 American and Filipino combat troops were taken prisoner when Bataan Peninsula fell to the Japanese invader on April 8, 1942. The prisoners' forced march to captivity is known as the Bataan Death March because harsh treatment and starvation caused the deaths of nearly 10,000 men.)

During the Korean War, Donald Drown re-enlisted and again became a Prisoner of War.

"Spence" (Daniel Spencer O'Brien) went to the University of Notre Dame. He worked for a commercial air conditioning company in California.

"About the summer of 1867 or 68, my mother was in the hospital and "oBriens helped my dad out by having me and my sister out. They were great to us. They took us to Laguna Beach, Newport. During that time, I found out that June dyed her hair and her daughters never kneww this. When I found out and was picking on her for dying her hair, then all her daughter fount out the big family secret. It caused quite a hullabaloo." David W. Hass, June 1996.

Spence used to collect old cars. He had a Jaguar and a Porche.

Spence and June owned a couple of condominiums in Palm Springs, California.

iii. STANLEY IRVIN HASS was born on 15 Jan 1927 in Chicago, Cook, Illinois. He died on 27 Jun 2012 in Phoenix, Maricopa, Arizona, USA. He married Patricia Mae LUCAS, daughter of Frank George LUCAS and Verbal Marie RICE, on 25 Aug 1947 in Chicago, Cook, Illinois. She was born on 12 Apr 1927 in Johnston City, Williamson, Illinois, USA. She died on 03 Sep 1992 in Phoenix, Maricopa, Arizona, USA (brainstem failure, subarachroid hemorrhage).

Stanley Irvin HASS was buried on 03 Jul 2012 in Elmhurst, Du Page, Illinois, USA (Mount Emblem Cemetery, North Parkway Section, Lot 144).

Notes for Stanley Irvin HASS:

"My grandfather, Stanley HASS got drafted into the third ARMY two weeks out of high school. He was inducted in 1945 at Ft.Sheridan and his platoon had to stand in line to sign their names and he was so surprised because so many people couldn't sign their names. One guy came up and said that he couldn't sign his name and the officer standing there said to just put an X on the line and as people went by so many put an X on the line.

"Stan had to stand in line to get shots. As you passed two doctors, one on each side would stick the shots in both shoulders.

"My grandfather got trench mouth and was in the forts hospital for a couple of weeks.

"At basic camp in Ft. Bragg he climbed walls a lot. One time his platoon had to crawl as machine guns shot over their heads so they couldn't get up. That doesn't seem very hard but they had to crawl on poison ivy. Stan and his platoon had to march with a full pack 15 miles in sand. One time they were going across a ravine on a rope and a private fell and broke his neck and died. When my Grandfather was training with a bazooka there were two dummy tanks set out in a field and he aimed between them hoping if it sailed left or right it would hit one. When he shot it went right where he aimed and missed them both. When Stan was training with the 50 caliber machinegun two people had to hold him down because of the recoil. One time the holders were late and he almost shot out the engines on the half track the gun was on was mounted on.

"He stayed at Ft . Bragg in the artillery and there was a special showing where General Patton was demonstrating a new shell that exploded about 15 feet above the ground and threw shrapnel down into fox holes to kill the men in them. After a year and a half it was time for furlough. He put in for over seas but didn't get to go. Instead he returned to Ft. Brag it had turned into a paratrooper fort and since he was with the artillery he got transferred to Ft.Knox.

"He was in one of the tank corps and taught trainees how to drive tanks. The tank he drove was the best we had it was the m-3l medium tank. It had a 105 Howitzer and a 50 caliber machinegun on it. The fun part was that he got to make his own roads so he would plow down trees as he drove around Ft.Knox. He was a T-5, Corporal technician. Stosh once had a trainee freeze at the wheel and they slammed into an oil barrel house filled with crude oil, luckily it isn't explode. "When you get on a tank you climb up the back using anything you can use to help get up. You turn by pulling up on a lever on your left and right. The gas pedals are at your feet and it's really hard to see. You get a lot of bruises because of the bumpy ride and that the inside is all metal. Stosh also was on Ft.Knox's baseball team. Each fort had its own team and in 1947 my grandfather's team won the ARMY championship. He also batted against Johnny Van Der Meer which soon became a St.Louis Cardinals. Stan played second base. My Grandfather left the army in 1948." Source: Daniel HASS, May 1996.

"Stanley I. HASS, 215 South Sixth Avenue, has enrolled for an 11- month course in watchmaking at the Elgin Watchmakers' college, Elgin, IL.

"The college, first school of its kind to be accredited by the United Horological Association of America, was established in 1920 by Elgin National Watch company. "Son of Mr. and Mrs. Stanley P. HASS, 3611 Copeland Place, Los Angeles, HASS attended Emerson grade school and Proviso High School. During World War II, he served for 16 months as a tank mechanic and instructor in the army." Source: newspaper article.

Their first child, Catherine Elizabeth, was born 27 Apr 1950 in Oak Park, Cook County, IL.

They lived at 125 Oak Street, Elgin, Illinois when their son, David Weston, was born on June 26, 1953 in Oak Park, Cook County, IL.

While working at the watch factory, Stan started working part time in the warehouse for Eby-Brown Company. Eventually left the watch factory and became a full-time salesman at Eby until retiring in February of 1989.

Stan moved to 14415 N. 20th Place, Phoenix, Arizona 85022 in December 1990 with his wife. Pat.

Around the summer of 1995, several years after Pat's death, Stan sold his house and moved in with his friend, Harriet MILLER.

Patricia Mae LUCAS was buried on 09 Sep 1992 in Elmhurst, Du Page, Illinois,

USA (Mount Emblem Cemetery, North Parkway Section, Lot 144).

Notes for Patricia Mae LUCAS:

She moved with her family to Maywood, IL before her second birthday.

She graduated from Proviso High School in June of 1945.

She worked at Fannie Mae Candy Company during WWII.

Patricia married Stanley Irvin HASS on August 25, 1947 in Chicago, Cook County, IL.

Pat suffered her first mental breakdown seven months after her marriage while living in California. She had problems the remainder of her life.

After moving back to Illinois, they had two children, Catherine Elizabeth HASS on April 27, 1950 and David Weston HASS on June 26, 1953. They lived at 125 Oak Street, Elgin, IL when their son was born.

Pat did exceptional needlework, primarily knitting and needlepointing. For a few years, around 1974 - 76, she worked part-time at a yarn craft store. She was an active member of a handwork club and held position(s) on the board for several years.

Stan and Pat moved to 14415 N. 20th Place, Phoenix, AZ in December of 1990. Pat collapsed suddenly as she rose from the dinner table on September 3, 1992. She was taken by paramedics to the hospital where she remained on life support for the legally required 24 hours.

Per death certificate - Patricia May HASS, age 65, died 03 Sep 1992 at John C. Lincoln Hospital in Phoenix, AZ of Cardiac failure due to brain stem failure due to subarachnoid hemorrhage. She was born 14 Apr 1927 in Johnson City, IL. She completed 12 years of school. Her social security number was 361-14-3888. Through Shadow Mountain Mortuary, 2350 E. Greenway Road, Phoenix, AZ, her body was sent to Mount Emblem Cemetery, Elmhurst, IL for burial. The informant for the death certificate information was her surviving husband, Stanley I. HASS, of 14415 N. 20th Place, Phoenix, AZ. [spelling of middle name and date of birth on the death certificate are wrong.]

iv. Donald Eugene Hass was born on 29 Nov 1928 in Chicago, Cook, Illinois. He married Janice Lianne JEFFERS, daughter of Sherman Rupert JEFFERS and Lucille Mildred Fredsdatter VAUGHN, on 14 Jul 1951. She was born on 23 Aug 1931 in Detroit, Wayne, Michigan, USA.

Notes for Donald Eugene HASS:

"When they were in Maywood, Don, who was younger than my father, Stan, was always following my dad. They had a big fight at a baseball game or something. Somehow, my dad ended up breaking Don's leg with a bat or sliding into second or something. The story was that my dad wouldn't help him or give him a ride home on his bike. They ended up making Don walk home with a broken leg." David W. Hass, June 1995.

"The football game was "Sandlot" football at high school. Don was hit from behind and Stan thought the leg wasn't really hurt and told Don to walk. When Stan saw it was broken, he rode Don home on their sister's bike." Lianne Hass, January 1997.

"When I was around 10 to 13 years old, his family came to visit us in Illinois during the winter. Eric and Marty had never been in snow and they wanted to play in the snow all the time. When they arrived I had already been out in the snow and was dripping wet and cold. They just wanted to stay out in the snow forever." David W. Hass, June 1996.

Donald E. Hass was a Test Conductor for the Lunar Excursion Module for the moon landing program. After he was with NASA's Lunar Excursion, when the space program was declining, he then transferred to their medical end where they designed medical equipment. At that point, he would tour all over the country with the gizmos.

"Don is so very busy with the Space Shuttle at Rockwell International where he is a Director with 300 people reporting directly to him." Lianne Hass, August 15, 1988
